**General Info:** The ride is on well-established trails at C Bar Stables in Valley Mills, TX. The terrain consists of a combination of gentle rolling hills, pasture and rocky caverns. Hoof protection is highly recommended. Helmets are required for all riders under 18 of age. **Membership for NATRC is free in 2019 if you have never been a member. Please visit [www.natrc.org](http://www.natrc.org) and sign up to be a member.** On-site registration for all Divisions will start at 1:00 pm Friday March 15<sup>th</sup> and check-in for Open/Novice/CP will begin at 2:00 pm on Friday. Late registration is available for Open/Novice/CP the day of the ride beginning at 6:30 am with late check-in beginning at 7:00 am Saturday March 16. Timeout on the trail will be at 7:30 am both days. Leisure Division registration is available beginning at 6:30 am the day of the ride. Check-in for Leisure Division will begin at 8:15 am Saturday and Sunday with time out onto the trail beginning at approximately 9:30 am both days.

**Camp Info:** Negative Coggins required. Camping consists of large pasture. There are 13 electric spots and they will be assigned to the first 13 people who pay in full for the ride. Electric spots are \$15 per day. Primitive camping is available for no charge. There is also a ranch fee for everyone of \$15 per day. There are 2 permanent porta potties, and there are limited water spigots. Volunteers camp for free. Horse water is available from a central source, but it is advisable to bring some water if you can for convenience.

**Meals:** Dinner is available for purchase Friday night for \$7 for everyone (there will be a donation basket to support the feeding of volunteers). Menu is shredded chicken with condiments, cowboy caviar, rolls and dessert. Saturday night bring your own meat to grill with potluck sides and desserts. Management will have a big grill setup for cooking. In addition to the dinners, breakfast and Lunch will be available for volunteers on Saturday and Sunday.

**Directions: GPS will guide you to the location.** From Whitney take TX-22 toward the lake and over the dam. Turn left on FM 56 and the follow it to County Road 3348. There is a sign for C-Bar. Follow the driveway into camp. From the south go to Valley Mills on Hwy 6 N (TX-6) and then turn on FM 56 to county road 3348.
